Applications are invited from suitable candidates for filling up the following purely temporary position of one Student Intern/Trainee under the Scientific Social Responsibility (SSR) for two months in the SERB project entitled “Deciphering role(s) of post-translational modifications and chromatin regulation of immunity in rice”, under the supervision of Dr. Subhra Chakraborty, Director, NIPGR. The details of the position are as under:

Student Intern/Trainee (One post): Consolidated Stipend ` . 5000/- per month (**tenure of post valid for two months**).

Qualification: Student currently pursuing the final year of B.Tech/B.Eng./M.Sc./M.Tech/M.Sc. in Molecular Biology/Biotechnology/Biochemistry/Plant Science/Life Sciences/Bioinformatics or related field are eligible to apply.

Interested candidates should send (i) bio-data, (ii) certificate from the head of the Institute/Department clearly indicating the current status of student and permission to attend the training if selected, (iii) copies of their marks sheets and (iv) a brief paragraph indicating their research interest.
