Applications are invited from suitable candidates for filling up the purely temporary position of one Project Associate-I (PA-I) in the “Short-Term Research Fellowship” programme, under the supervision of Dr. Mukesh Kumar Meena, Scientist, BRIC-NIPGR.

Name of the Position: Project Associate-I (PA-I) - (One post)

Upper age limit: 35 years

Eligibility: A candidate having Master’s degree in Plant biology/Botany/Genetics/Biochemistry/Biotechnology/ Agriculture/life sciences with at least 55% (or equivalent) marks can apply. Candidates with NET and also those who qualify as per the criteria mentioned in the DST Office Memorandum number SR/S9/Z-05/2019 dated July 10, 2020 are eligible to apply.

Candidate must be having research experience in the area of (i) plant-insect interaction (ii) RNA-seq (iii) plant transformation. Candidates with previous work experience in *Arabidopsis thaliana* and/or plant insects handling will be preferred.

Desirable: Experience of gene cloning, confocal microscopy and general molecular biology techniques are desirable.

The Fellowship amount for the above positions is at par with the similar fellowships by DBT/DST. BRIC-NIPGR reserves the right to select the candidate against the above post depending upon the qualifications and experience of the candidate. Reservation of posts shall be as per Govt. of India norms. The position may be terminated any time by giving a month notice by either side. The applicants will have no claim implicit or explicit for consideration against any regular position of BRIC-NIPGR. The initial appointment will be for one year or till the tenability of the scheme whichever is earlier and the same can be curtailed/extended on the basis of assessment of the candidate's performance and discretion of the Competent Authority.

Walk-in-Interview Details:

Eligible candidates may appear for **Walk-in-Interview** at BRIC-National Institute of Plant Genome Research (BRIC-NIPGR), Aruna Asaf Ali Marg, New Delhi – 110067 on **Monday, May 18, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.** along with the duly filled in application form in the prescribed format. The duly filled application form along with the educational certificate must be submitted at the time of registration at BRIC-NIPGR from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on May 18, 2026. Any candidate reporting after 11:00 a.m. will not be entertained for walk-in-interview. The candidate must ascertain their eligibility before applying, as ineligible candidates will not be interviewed. All the candidates are requested to appear for the interview with complete bio-data, earlier dissertation thesis, publications in copy (if any) and original degree/experience certificates and transcripts. Canvassing in any form or bringing influence, political or otherwise, will lead to disqualification of the candidate(s).

Note: Incomplete application and those in the wrong format will be summarily rejected. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the walk-in-interview.
