Candidates are invited to appear before selection committee in the walk-in-interview for filling up the purely temporary position of one **Senior Research Fellow/ Project Associate-II**, in the Gates foundation funded project entitled "Development of climate resilient chickpea and brassica by gene editing", under the supervision of Dr. Senthil-Kumar Muthappa, Scientist, NIPGR.

(1) Senior Research Fellow/Project Associate-II (One Post): Emoluments: ₹ 42,000/- plus 27% HRA per month as per norms and as sanctioned in the project.

Candidates having Master's degree in Life Sciences with at least 55% (or equivalent) marks in master degree and a minimum of two year of post M.Sc. research experience can apply. The project work requires experience of working with plant host-pathogen interaction and this will be a shortlisting criterion.

For SRF/PA-II, candidates with NET and also those who qualify as per the criteria mentioned in the DST Office Memorandum number SR/S9/Z-08/2018 dated January 30, 2019 and SR/S9/Z-05/2019 dated July 10, 2020 are eligible to apply. The upper age limit for PA-II will be 35 years.

The above positions are completely on temporary basis and co-terminus with the project. The fellowship/emolument amount for the above positions are as sanctioned in the project and as per NIPGR/DBT/DST norms. The initial appointment will be for one year or till the tenability of the project whichever is earlier and the same can be curtailed/extended on the basis of assessment of the candidate's performance and discretion of the Competent Authority. NIPGR reserves the right to select the candidate against the above post depending upon the qualification and experience of the candidate. Reservation of posts shall be as per Govt. of India norms. The appointment may be terminated any time by giving one-month notice by either side. The applicants will have no claim implicit or explicit for consideration against any regular position of NIPGR.

Eligible candidates may appear for walk-in-interview at BRIC-National Institute of Plant Genome Research (BRIC-NIPGR), Aruna Asaf Ali Marg, New Delhi – 110 067 on **Monday, June 08, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.** onwards along with the duly filled in application form in the prescribed format. The duly filled application form along with self-attested copies of the date of birth, educational & experience certificates must be submitted at

the time of registration at BRIC-NIPGR from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Any candidate reporting after 11:00 a.m. will not be entertained for walk-in interview. The candidates must ascertain eligibility before applying, as ineligible candidates will not be interviewed. All the candidates are requested to appear for the interview with complete bio-data in given format and original degree/experience certificates and transcripts for verification. Canvassing in any form or bringing influence, political or otherwise, will lead to the disqualification of the candidate(s). Note: Incomplete application and those in the wrong format will be summarily rejected. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the walk-in-interview.
